Stop the Spread

Unfortunately we have seen an increase of Covid and cold like symptoms within our staff members. As we continue to support each other and our supported individuals please ensure all staff continue to follow the below outlined infection control procedures:

- Wear a medical grade mask at all times in the workplace Staff can increase masking level to N95 if preferred
- Perform a Rapid Antigen Test before coming to work, even when called in on short notice. This should be completed at least three times a week unless you have been directed otherwise.
- **Do Not** come to work when symptomatic (i.e. headache, nasal congestion, sore throat, cough, etc.). Notify scheduling, the supervisor and Occupational Health when symptoms develop.
- If you are symptomatic or have a positive Rapid Antigen Test contact the supervisor and Occupational Health immediately. Make an appointment for a PCR test at Ongwanada Pharmacy.
- It is important to follow directions given regarding Work Isolation when you
 have been identified as a close contact. Direction will be provided
 regarding Rapid Antigen Testing, PPE and masking. Please ensure to follow
 these instructions for the entire timeline identified by Occupational Health
 or Clinical Resource Nurse.

These measures are intended to keep you safe and the people we support safe as well as limit the spread of infections.
